The WCMA AGM was a great success; we had a good turnout for both the meetings during the day on Saturday and also at the banquet.

Meeting Highlights:

- WCMA is starting to modernize by moving to hard card licenses and online licence renewal and registration.
- Castrol Raceway in Edmonton paved a short track and there are hopes that more paving will be done by next season to create a long track.
- Work is underway to create the Rockyview Motorsport Resort in Airdrie Alberta, but at the moment they are still trying to raise \$50 million to get started.
- A new director is needed for SoloSport.
- SoloSport is looking for input for safety regulations from the regions for Time Attack.
- AutoSlalom Championship is coming back to Western Canada, so start preparing bids to host. It will be a 3 day event and will be eligible for \$2000 in sponsorship money from Toyo Tires.

Road Race Report

I had decided to end our Road Race season with the September weekend, canceling the events we had scheduled for October 5-7. We had only 3 people enrolled for the driver school and the September Lapping Day was way under-attended. Based on that, and gambling on the weather and Thanksgiving, I announce cancellation to save us losing money. I planned to end up with a little over \$3000 surplus. This will be needed to cover anticipated expenses like replacing the T&S laptop, whose space bar has died, replacing a few transponders and considering new radios for next year.

Although the car count was down for September and the weather was chilly with some rain on Saturday, we had some very good racing and minimal breakage. We had 2 out of province cars including Jed Harrison from Edmonton who rolled in Saturday night and did some good racing on Sunday. This gave us a total of 18 cars. We also succeeded in getting the most destructive of our runoff strips in Corner 8 replaced with large cement blocks thanks to several racers and marshals with strong backs.

The overall season can be considered quite successful despite the fact that a couple of our grander schemes didn't pan out. We successfully got our 5th race weekend back and should have no trouble keeping it. Participation in the Friday Lapping Days was up quite a bit. Our race grids averaged 21.4 cars, compared with 16 in 2011. The Solo Sprint (Time Attack) grid was pretty stable around 5 or 6 cars but involving more than twice that number of people and it had no costs associated with it.

It's also good to see a number of the newer racers getting quite competitive. Take a look at the videos through Al Marcoux's windshield on the Road Race Forum and you'll see some cars evading the old master who are only on their second or third year of racing. Lots of people looked like they were having a very good time.

At the last minute I was persuaded to run a Lapping Day on Saturday October 6. It gave us a chance to finish the track repairs Saturday morning thanks to a number of racers and workers who came early, manned shovels and pick ax and lifted heavy blocks. We were a little stunned to find several inches of crusted snow on every bit of the track except the main straight. It took a lot of slow lapping/otherwise known as snow plowing to get down to wet pavement. We only had 8 lappers but they claimed to enjoy the challenge of the slippery conditions which gradually changed as the track dried out. They agreed to pay an equal share of what our costs were. I was able to eliminate some costs so we almost broke even. Our two new rumble strips in Corners 8 and 9 are now complete. I'll sneak up some day in the spring and paint them alternating colors so everyone can tell they are "Off Track".

Finally I want to thank everyone who helped make this run so well this year. I made a lot of specific requests for help and was never once disappointed. Thanks to every one of you. I'm pretty sure you know who you are. Bless you all.
