This is still the pre-season for Road Race so lots of what I've been doing is trying to get the word out on events this summer that would benefit from a huge turnout. I am open to any effective form of putting the word out there. We've done an extensive emailing as well as posts on the Forum. There has been a pretty good level of response in the form of questions raised. The Chump Car information has been out there for a month or two and the GT Challenge stuff has been out about a month. I can confirm about 10 entries and a number of probable ones. I sent copies to Alberta with a request for circulation as well as the IIRA in Minnesota and the club in Thunder Bay. I was interviewed March 30 by the Gimli radio station to promote our 2 large events at the track this summer. This station and the station owner is a major supporter of what we are bringing to Gimli, as is the mayor.

The school is nearly full as I write this and entries keep trickling in. We had 39 entrants Tuesday night when I last checked. Most of the entries so far specify Race as their interest. I suspect a number of Chump Car drivers are taking advantage of our school, as well they should. We have a fairly large group from Regina.

The runoff area off corner 8 is being fixed this Friday, thanks to Grant Kubay who is coming up to move some dirt and make the surface level instead of a big hole. The RM is redoing the electricity next week. Keith and I are scheduled to talk to the GIDC Board about doing some Concession Building renovations.

It looks like a great summer.
